1. INTRODUCTION TO ASIA DIVE EXPO (ADEX) 2016

ABOUT ADEX

Boasting a history of 21 years, <u>ADEX</u> has been, and is still, the biggest and longest-running dive expo in Asia. It is one of the industry's "must-attend" events. From across the globe, it brings together distinguished VIPs and speakers, business owners, dive operators, enthusiasts, marine conservationists, and everybody with a passion for the underwater world. The event is endorsed by major organisations in the industry, such as DEMA (USA), the Singapore Tourism Board (STB), and the Singapore Underwater Federation (SUF).

Successfully organised by <u>Underwater360</u> (UW360) for seven years, ADEX continues to attract strong crowds of trade exhibitors and industry icons, drawing enthusiasts who want to meet and mingle with the professionals, and learn about the latest gear, the best dive trips, and the work of the industry's most creative people. ADEX 2016 attracted a total of 57,793 visitors over its three days.

ADEX 2016 SCHEDULE

Taking place over three days from April 15–17, 2016, at Suntec Singapore, Halls 401 to 403, ADEX 2016 brought in world-renowned marine life artists, marine conservationists, and underwater photographers and videographers to speak about their passion and their work.

ADEX 2016 ICON

Each year, the show is dedicated to an iconic marine species, with activities designed to heighten awareness of its conservation. This year's ADEX icon was the majestic seahorse, and the show featured numerous talks and activities designed to educate the public about the issues that threaten these delicate animals. ADEX attendees learned how they can do their part to help protect seahorses and their habitats.

The ADEX official publication, *Asian Diver*, has an annual ADEX edition to commemorate the event. Called "The Big Blue Book", it is designed to be the ultimate reference guide, with the bulk of the publication focusing on everything you need to know about the majestic seahorse. It also serves as a show guide for ADEX, including event information, speaker details, and schedules.


Fig 5. Floor Area
